### ELECTIVE POLICY

Grooming students to become accomplished singers at the high school level requires a comprehensive and cumulative effort. Students who “skip” taking choir in grades 7 and 8 miss two years of crucial training for what lies ahead in high school choir.

Therefore, students who take choir in 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> grade, but opt out of taking 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade choir in order to take other electives will not be permitted to audition for high school choir at the end of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year.

Exceptions to this policy will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
